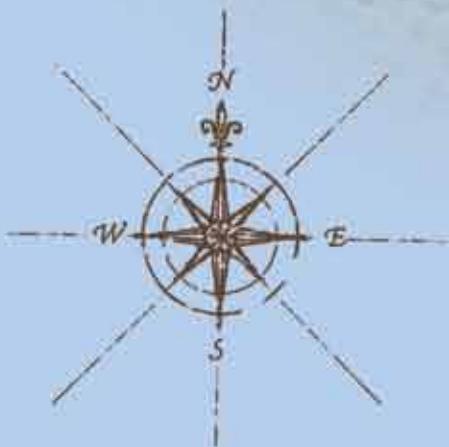

Brig. Gen. under Napoleon and 13th Prime Minister
of France, 1834.*

Thomas Jefferson (1743-1826) 3rd President.
